Opening Day was livened up somewhat by several canoeists nose diving over the side. One in particular bit the dust when his canoe was leading, what judgement?

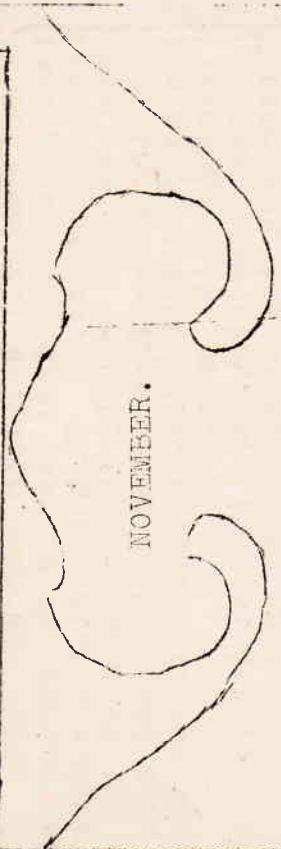
Another canoeist is saving up corks to tie on his new set of false teeth, his last set didnt float.
